

Park Re-Opening Notice – May 14, 2020

Today Premier Ford announced that seasonal parks can open as of May 16th.

This is great news and we look forward to allowing members to access their trailer sites. However, as we resume operations it will not be business as usual. This will be a **phased** resumption of operations over the course of a few weeks to ensure your safety. This will require cooperation, patience and compliance with the new operating procedures that will be implemented and updated as necessary.

As of May 16, 2020, at 12:01 a.m., access cards will be re-activated for all paid up members. Common areas are still off limits and members should go to their own trailer sites. Water will be on with a ***boil water advisory*** in place until testing is completed.

Signed social distancing acknowledgments are required from each Member. Please download and complete the form at home prior to visiting the park if you have access to a printer (<https://greenacrescampersgroup.com/covid-19-updates/> and download **GACG-Social Distancing - May 14, 2020**). If you have previously signed and submitted this acknowledgement, it is not necessary to do so again. Either of Steve Knox or Chess Pajak will be generally available over the long weekend to provide this form and other social distancing materials to members as they arrive. Members are being asked to complete the form as an acknowledgment that we all share the responsibility to keep our park safe and to protect the most vulnerable members of our community.

In this first phase, the park office will remain closed. Public common areas such as the clubhouse, playground and games area remain off-limits. The park phone is currently going to voicemail. More information will follow on the general park re-opening including the pool and the clubhouse as we receive written clarification from the Province and the Township.

We all know the rules of social distancing and what is required to ensure personal safety and we expect that all of the best practices we observe elsewhere will be adhered to while at Park. We will also work with the membership to implement additional rules to ensure that everyone remains healthy and safe.

- Please keep a 2-metre distance, at a minimum. If that cannot be maintained a mask/face covering is recommended.
- If you are experiencing any of the symptoms of COVID-19, do not come to the Park and if you are unsure what the symptoms are please complete the self-assessment at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>.
- If you are currently off work for a 14-day isolation/quarantine period do not come to the Park!
- When you come to the Park go straight to your trailer site. Gatherings in common areas or on the roads are not permitted at this time.
- No visitors. Only members and their immediate family are permitted in the Park. Ideally, no more than 5 people should be at a trailer site at one time unless they are all part of your immediate family.

It is great news that we can move forward with opening, but please remember this is **phase one**. Everyone needs to do their part and take the rules seriously. Failing to follow and adhere to social distancing protocols will only lead to setbacks. We are in this together and want to have an enjoyable season at the Park. In the meantime, stay safe, keep your distance, wash your hands often, and we look forward to seeing everyone from a safe distance.
